Cell phone Texting (NET CETERA)

Any child with a cell phone probably uses it to send and receive text message and images. It 's similar to using email or instant messaging and most of the same etiquette and safety rules apply. If you kids are texting, encourage them to:

1. Respect others. Think about how a text message might be read and understood before sending it;
2. Ignore text messages from people they don 't know;
3. Learn how to block number from their cell phone;
4. Avoid posting their cell phone number online;
5. Never provide financial information in response to a text message.

Student Tuition Financial Assistance

Parents/Legal Guardians wanting to apply for student tuition assistance with the Santa Fe Archdiocese must complete an application online. The cost of the application is \$20 (to our knowledge). You should complete the application as early as possible since funds are disbursed in April. You will need the following information to complete your application:

- Copies of your IRS Federal Form 1040, 1040A, or 1040 EZ U.S. Individual Income Tax Return, including supporting tax Schedules C, E, F. If applicant and co-applicant file separately, we require both tax returns for the same tax year. We do NOT accept State tax returns;
- Copies of all W-2 Wage and Tax Statements for both you and your spouse. NOTE: If you are applying before you have received all W-2 Wage and Tax Statements, please submit them as soon as they become available;
- Copies of all supporting documentation for household Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, workers' Compensation, and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF).
- Payment of your nonrefundable \$20 application fee;
- Signature required for paper applications only. Paper applications received with a signature will not be processed.

Please do not submit multiple applications. FACTS will process one application per household-either a paper application or an online application. Following your online application, submit a letter to the Archdiocese, requesting student assistance, OR include your letter with the application if you mail it in. The office can provide some assistance with this letter. FAXED or COPIED application will not be accepted! FACTS Grant & Aid Application for beginning fall 2011:

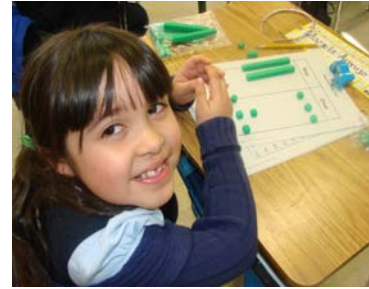

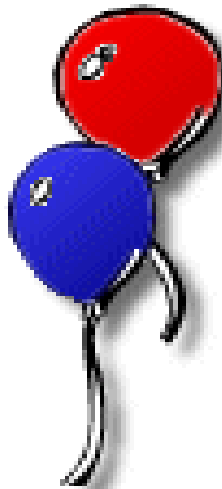
