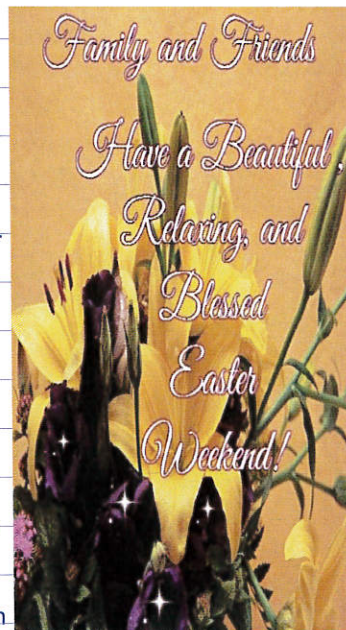
The drawing will be held on May 23rd. Stop by the school office and take a look at this beautiful quilt!
