Dress Code/Uniform

We believe that standards of dress are necessary for our school. It is our professional belief that a direct relationship often exists between dress, grooming, and patterns of behavior and performance. We would like to instill personal pride in everyone in our school. Therefore, the parents and faculty will enforce the following uniform dress code.

Boys- will wear:

- Navy blue uniform slacks (no cargo pants or sweatpants)
- Boys in grades 1st-8th will wear a belt with shirt tucked in.
- Navy blue knee-length uniform shorts
- Navy Blue HCCS polo
- Navy blue/black (one-fold) socks - must be visible and above the ankle
- Solid black belt with pants/shorts
- No crocs or light up shoes.

Girls- will wear:

- Navy blue skirts, skorts, shorts, jumpers, or uniform pants (**must not be shorter than the knees**)
- Girls **MUST** wear a skirt or a jumper and not leggings alone. If they wear the leggings only then they are out of uniform.
- Girls' 1st-8th will wear a belt with shirt tucked in.
- Navy Blue HCCS polo
- Navy blue/black (one-fold) socks - **must be visible** and above the ankle, navy blue leotards or knee-high socks with skirts/jumpers
- Solid black belt with pants/shorts
- No crocs or light up shoes.

Mass-Boys will wear light blue-collar shirts. Girls will wear a plaid 76 jumper or skirt with a light blue-collar shirt.

During the cold seasons, only the following are acceptable for both boys and girls:

- Solid navy-blue jacket and/or the HCCS winter jacket (can be purchased through the school office)
- HCCS hooded sweatshirt or solid navy blue
- Solid navy-blue hoodie or sweater, no insignias.

T-Shirt Mondays

Every Monday students may wear their navy blue HCCS T-shirt/polo shirt with uniform pants, shorts, skirt or jeans. T-Shirts can only be worn on Mondays

School uniforms must be always worn except when approved by the principal. Students participating in the school-sponsored athletic programs (basketball, cheerleading, or drill team) may change into athletic uniforms in preparation for basketball games, pep assemblies, etc., when necessary. Clothing should not fit tight but be comfortable to wear. HCCS provides parents with information on how to obtain student uniforms during registration.

The following are not allowed at HCCS:

- fingernail polish (except for light-colored nail polish), or fake fingernails
- Facial make-up
- jewelry (girls may wear small, studded earrings only) - no “dangling” earrings. Only ONE earring per ear.
- body piercing
- tattoos (including temporary)
- Glitter

Hair

- No artificial hair tails, Mohawk haircuts, or other hairstyle fads, including hair carvings are allowed.
- Colored, dyed, “streaked”, highlights, or bleached hair is not permitted.
- Boy’s hair should not be longer than the top of the shirt collar.
- No bowl haircuts or other fads.

If your child is unable to comply with the dress code due to medical reasons, you must submit a doctor’s explanation to the office.

Dress Code Violations

All violations of the HCCS uniform code result in a \$5.00 fine.
